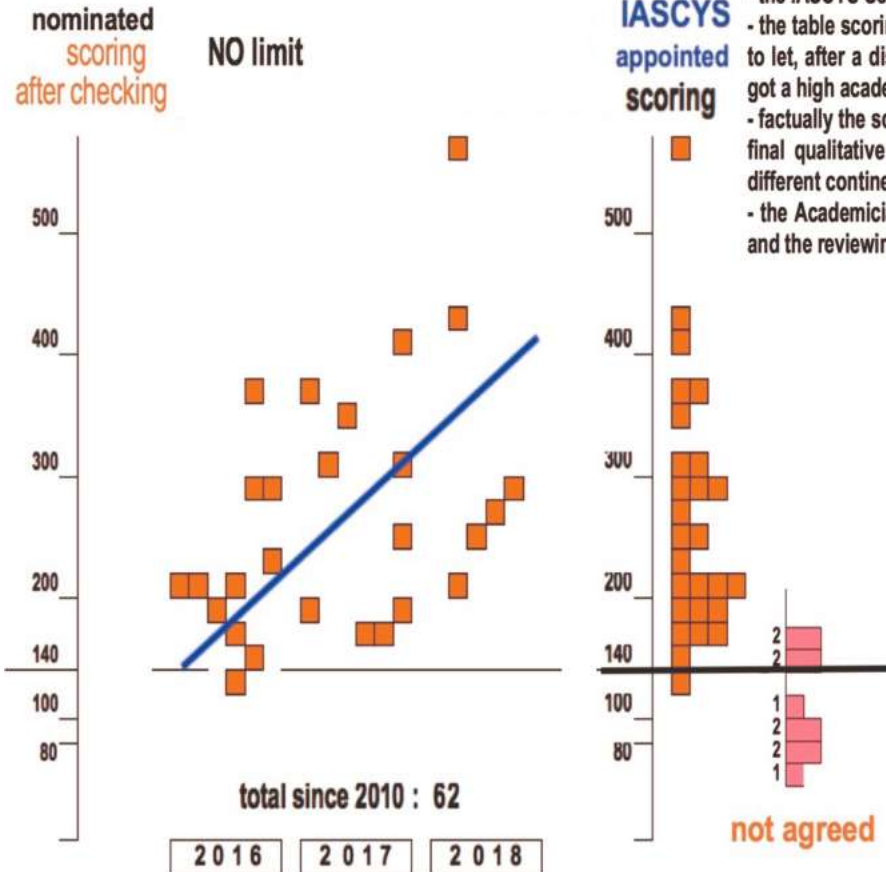
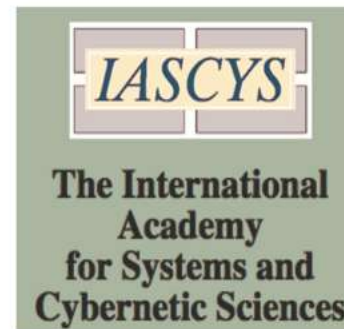


scores evolution of appointed Academicians



- nominations can be sent to the IASCYS EC by e-mail either by a IFSR, EUS-EUS or WOSC member Society or by another renown international organization, or is proposed by the IASCYS EC itself
- the nomination sheet must provide the detailed CV and the scoring table of the applicant
- the IASCYS Secretary General checks the data that are sent to all IASCYS EC members
- the table scoring, which is a quantitative resume of the detailed CV, provides a framework to let, after a discussion by e-mails exchange, the IASCYS EC to judge if a candidate has got a high academic reputation or not
- factually the score is only one of other important standards, so after the EC agreement the final qualitative decision is given by a reviewing team of 3 other Academicians from 3 different continents
- the Academician appointment diploma mentions both the EC members (5 Academicians) and the reviewing team (3 Academicians) and eventually the Society
