The results are as follow:

Currently

68 Academicians are alive. So **the qualified majority is 35 and the two-thirds majority is 46.**

After deleting double votes, 46 Academicians have voted in due time.

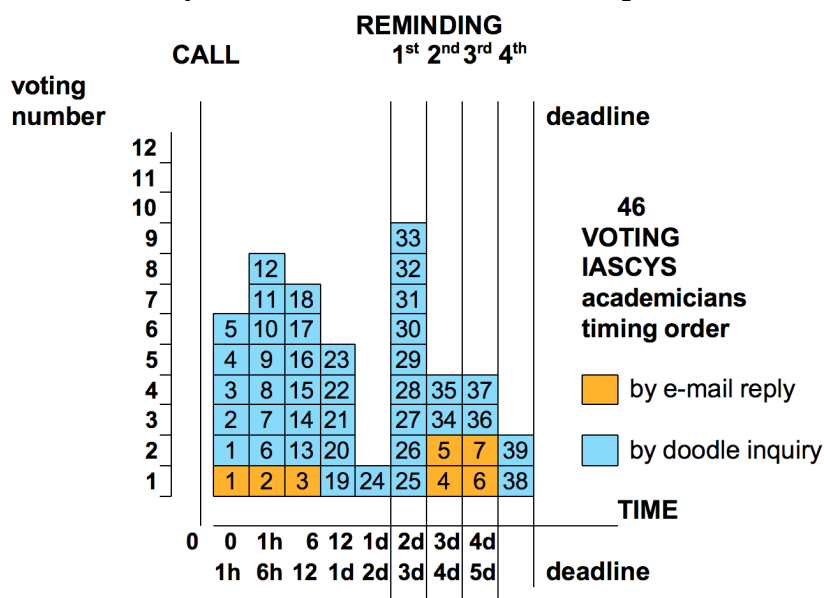

With 46 votes (two-thirds majority), the final result is: YES 44, NO 1, ABSTAIN 1.

Even if we could consider that not voting people are indeed voting NO, that really means: **44 YES (qualified majority is 35), 23 NO and 1 ABSTAIN.** So, according to the IASCYS statutes, the new IASCYS EC to be registered again in France for 4 years, is as follows:

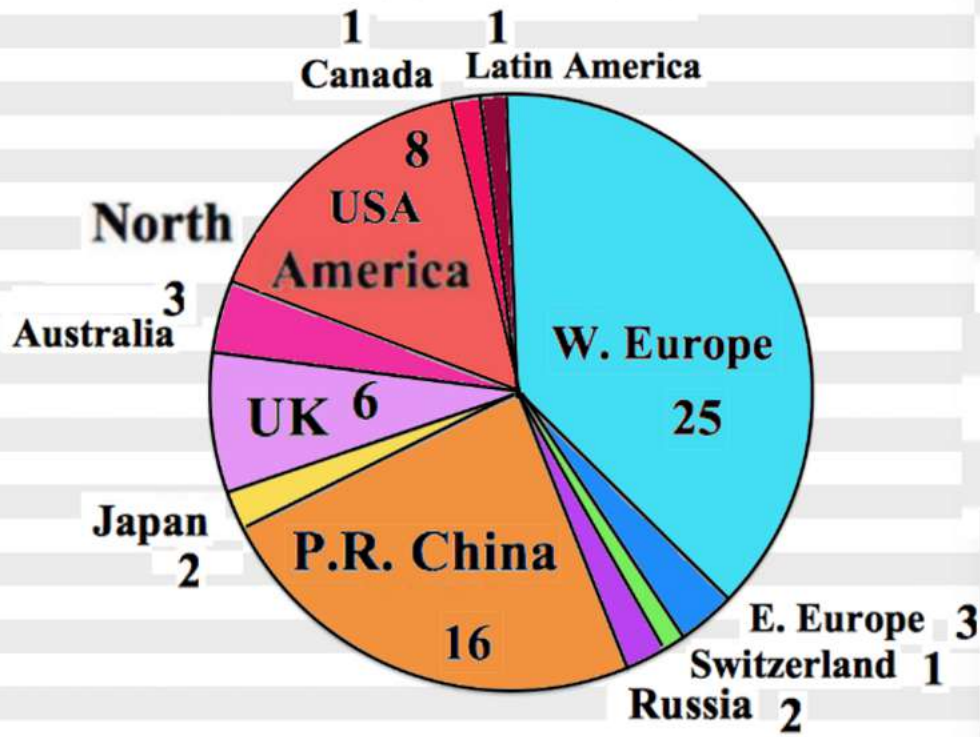

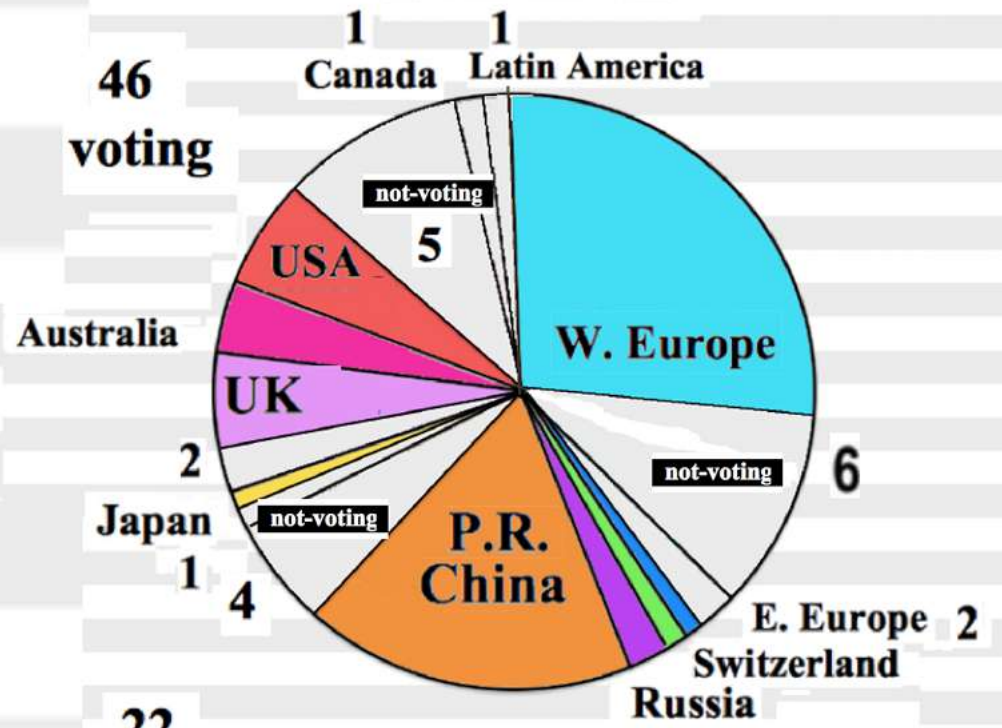

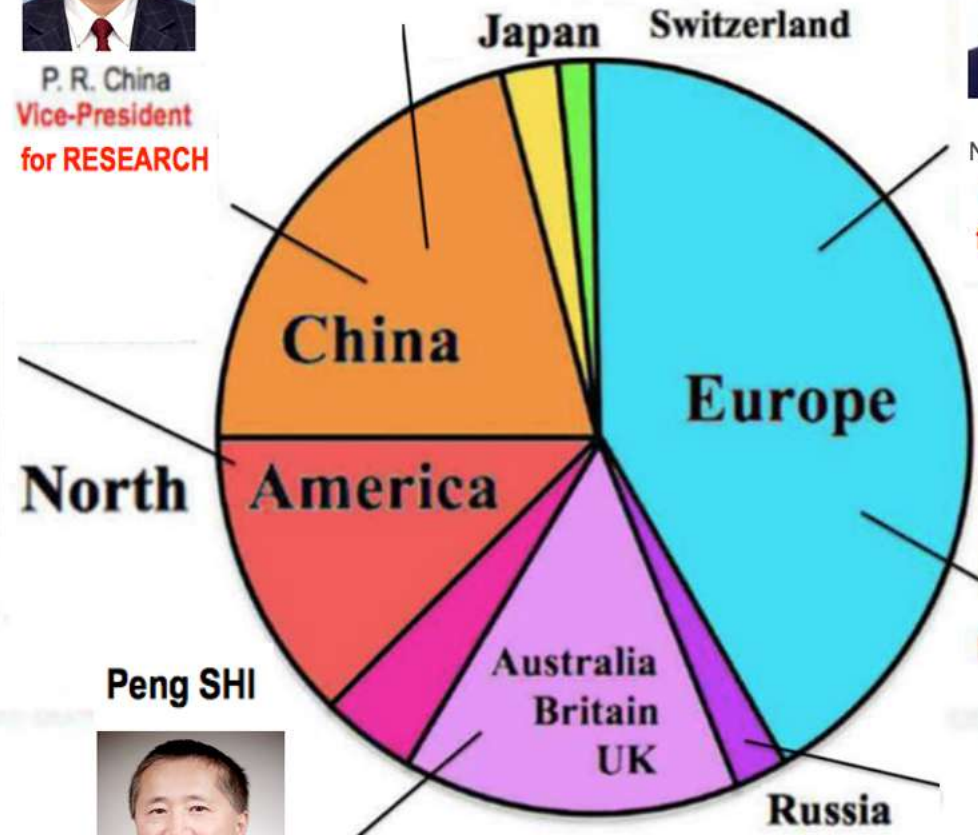
