## IASCYS INTERNAL RULES according to the French by-law for 1901 Associations as registered by the IASCYS EC on 14 July 2016

## Article 5 – IASCYS Management

- 5.1. IASCYS is managed by an EC of 5 elected Academicians. The EC is elected by the IASCYS GA.
- 5.2. The President of the IASCYS EC shall be the chief spokesman for IASCYS. She/he shall preside over all IASCYS GA and EC Meetings. She/he shall be responsible for the monitoring of members' needs and coordination of the efforts of IASCYS academicians and officers.
- 5.3. Up to 3 Vice Presidents can be elected by the IASCYS GA to assist the President in the coordination of the IASCYS activities in specific areas agreed upon by the IASCYS EC. Honorary Personalities of the IASCYS (like for example Honorary President of the IASCYS) are true full members of the EC, on the proposal of the EC.

Robert Trappl was appointed once, and 'ad vitam eternam', his membership is not submitted to re-election. But he has no vote for the EC decision, he is outside of the 5, he is an adviser of the EC. He is informed of all the EC discussions and decisions but without voting for this decisions.

- 13. Criteria for <u>honorary membership of IASCYS</u> include:
- 13.1 Establishment and/or more than 20 years of office in an IFSR member association and/or IFSR.
- 13.2 Authorship of unique contributions such as The International Encyclopaedia of Systems and Cybernetics, establishment and/or running a S&C related journal for 10 years at least.
